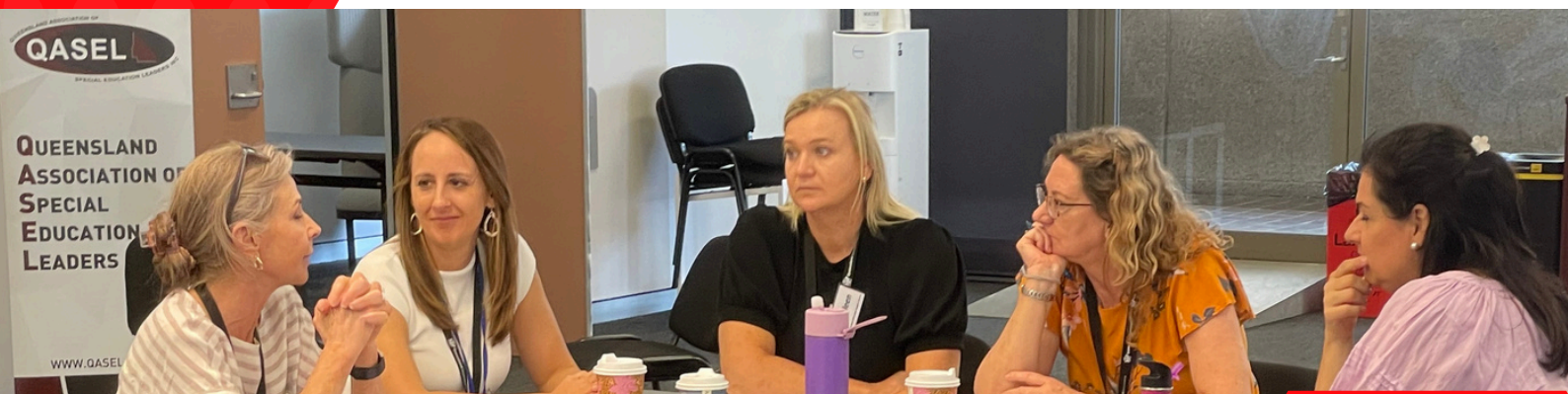

- What is coaching and why is it an effective model for supporting change in schools?
- What are the qualities of a good coach?
- How do you grow your coaching skills?
- How do you set a goal for coaching?
- How do you have a coaching conversation that leads to change?



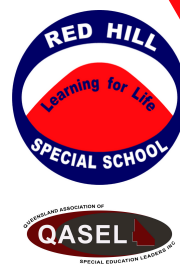
NOTE: In order to attend Day 2 only, you must have completed Day 1 within the last three years.
